

## Years 3 and 4 Action Plans: July 1, 2023- June 30, 2025

## ACTION PLAN 1. EXPAND OUR FOCUS ON NEURODIVERSITY TO INCREASE ACCESS TO STUDENTS WITH VARYING LEARNING STYLES.

Action Plan Leader: Hilary Meyer Vice President: Jodi Koslow Martin

- 1. Host instruction and programming series on neurodiversity for students, faculty, staff, and community members.
- Select three locations across campus where students study outside of the classroom, complete a thorough assessment, and provide recommendations for improvement to increase inclusion of neurodiverse learners.
- 3. Leverage the experience of campus and community employers involved in the S.E.E.D program to identify how neurodivergent students at Triton College can prepare for the workplace.

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs):

- 1. Implement three programs a year on the topic of serving neurodiverse students. At least 75% of surveyed attendees demonstrate that program objectives have been met.
- 2. Collect student feedback on existing spaces. Create messaging to new and continuing students who have different study preferences.

## ACTION PLAN 2. ACCELERATE CREDENTIALING AND ADVANCEMENT IN THE WORKFORCE FOR ADULT STUDENTS.

Action Plan Leader: Paul Jensen Vice President: Sean Sullivan

- 1. Redesign the college's Back to College for Adults website and improve online visibility.
- 2. Revise Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) options and train providers.
- 3. Explore Competency-Based Education (CBE) for possible implementation.
- 4. Leverage Career Services' HR Roundtable employer advisory group to provide ongoing insight and perspective on the adult market.

## Key Performance Indicators (KPIs):

- 1. Redesigned working adult-focused webpages with student success stories, metrics, contacts, program information, and links; search engine-optimized (Y1)
- 2. Five faculty trained in assessing prior learning by CAEL (Y1); PLA practices reviewed and revised (Y2)
- 3. Proposed CBE instruction model (Y2)
- 4. Biannual reports with guidance on strategies for better serving adult students (Y1,2)
